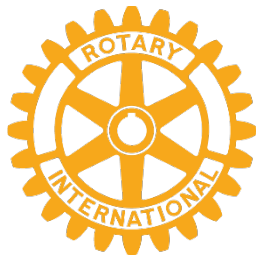

Evergreen program donation wish list:

- Markers of different sorts. A lot of what we have is dried out. Washable, permanent, fat, thin, etc.
- Different types of paint (acrylic, watercolor, fabric paints, etc.) and small bristle paint brushes. We do have larger foam paint brushes.
- Table coverings/cloths and smocks/shirts for the children.
- Glue – Sticks, Elmers, etc.
- Stickers (The younger kids love animals, sports, and decorative stickers. The older teens and parents like the "word" type of stickers that say things like "love" or "family," etc.)
- Cardstock, construction paper.
